Dosage:

Adults: As prescribed by a registered medical practitioner. Generally 1 tablet 1–2 times daily depending on severity. Not recommended for children unless prescribed.

Possible Side Effects:

- Drowsiness
- Dry mouth
- Nausea
- Mild dizziness
- Stomach discomfort

Contraindications & Precautions:

Avoid in severe hypertension and liver disorders without supervision. Use cautiously in diabetes and heart disease. Avoid alcohol. Consult doctor during pregnancy and lactation.

Storage Instructions:

Store below 25°C. Protect from moisture and sunlight. Keep out of reach of children.
