

Cefpodoxime Clavulanic Acid Dry Syrup – SPINXO CLAV Dry Syrup

Product Composition

Each 5 ml of reconstituted SPINXO CLAV Dry Syrup contains:

- Cefpodoxime Proxetil IP – 50 mg
- Clavulanic Acid IP – 31.25 mg
- Flavoured base q.s.
- Supplied with sterile water for reconstitution

Key Ingredients

Cefpodoxime: A broad-spectrum cephalosporin antibiotic effective against various bacterial infections.

Clavulanic Acid: A beta-lactamase inhibitor that prevents bacteria from breaking down Cefpodoxime, enhancing its effectiveness.

Uses and Indications

Cefpodoxime proxetil clavulanate syrup is used in pediatric patients for the treatment of upper and lower respiratory tract infections, acute otitis media, tonsillitis, pharyngitis, acute bacterial sinusitis, urinary tract infections, and skin and soft tissue infections. It offers excellent coverage against Gram-positive and Gram-negative pathogens, including ESBL-producing organisms.

Mechanism of Action

Cefpodoxime proxetil is a prodrug that converts into active cefpodoxime after oral administration. It inhibits bacterial cell wall synthesis, resulting in bacterial cell death. Clavulanic acid inhibits beta-lactamase enzymes, protecting cefpodoxime from degradation and ensuring sustained antimicrobial efficacy.

Dosage and Administration

Dosage should be determined by a pediatrician based on age, body weight, and severity of infection. The syrup is generally administered twice daily. Shake well before use, measure the dose accurately, and preferably administer after food. Do not exceed the prescribed dose or duration.

Side Effects

Possible side effects include mild diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, abdominal discomfort, and skin rash. Rare allergic reactions may occur and require immediate medical attention.

Contraindications and Precautions

Contraindicated in patients with hypersensitivity to cephalosporins or clavulanic acid. Use with caution in children with gastrointestinal disorders or renal impairment. Not recommended without

medical supervision.

Drug Interactions

May interact with anticoagulants, probenecid, and oral vaccines. Physicians should be informed of all concurrent medications.

Storage Instructions

Store below 25°C. Protect from moisture and direct sunlight. After reconstitution, store as directed and use within the prescribed period. Keep out of reach of children.
